Smoke detector (two), heat detector, fire extinguisher, fire blanket, torch, instructions regarding fire exits, no smoking.

People at risk?

Guests & visitors all provided with fire safety instructions and fire exit procedures.

Evaluation:

Risk of fire starting is minimal.

Accidental fires can be avoided by complying with fire safety rules.

Electrical appliances checked annually.

Fire extinguishers checked annually.

Smoke detectors checked weekly.

Heat detectors checked weekly.

Very unlikely anything could be pushed onto something that could cause a fire.

Keep exits clear.

Records / Plan:

Update the risk assessment annually.
